**BULLETIN OF ACTS
OF THE
REPUBLIC OF SURINAME**

Act of March 10, 2003 containing the approval of the “ Revised Treaty of Chaguaramas establishing the Caribbean Community including the CARICOM Single Market and Economy”

THE PRESIDENT OF THE REPUBLIC OF SURINAME

Having taken into consideration that it is desirable to submit to The National Assembly for approval , the Treaty called “Revised Treaty of Chaguaramas establishing the Caribbean Community including the CARICOM Single Market and Economy”, signed by Suriname at Nassau, Bahamas on July 5, 2001, which approval pursuant to article 104, paragraph 1 of the Constitution has to be granted by Law.

Having heard the Council of State, after approval of The National Assembly, has ratified the Act stated below.

Article 1

The Treaty signed by Suriname at Nassau, Bahamas on July 5, 2001, called “Revised Treaty of Chaguaramas establishing the Caribbean Community including the CARICOM Single Market and Economy”, is approved.

Article 2

1. This Act is promulgated in the Gazette of the Republic of Suriname.
2. It comes into force as of the day following its promulgation.
